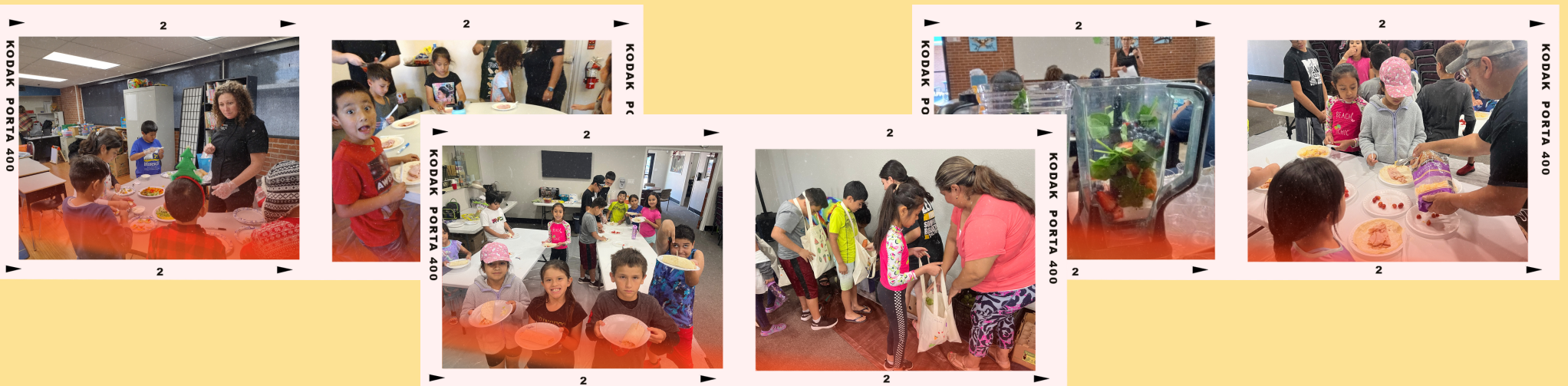
Hit a homerun with fruits and veggies!

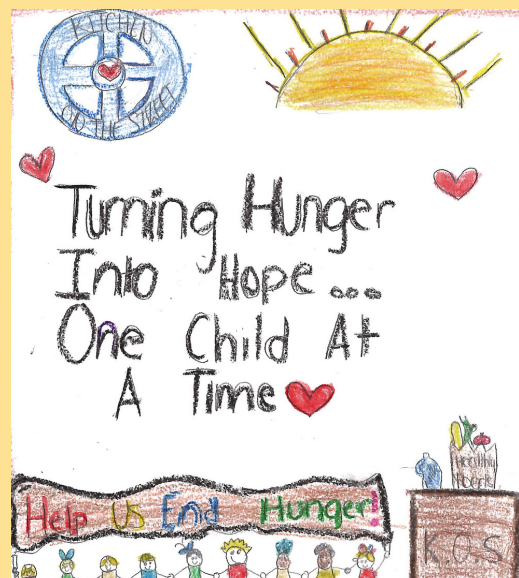
## Impact

## Where do you fit In?

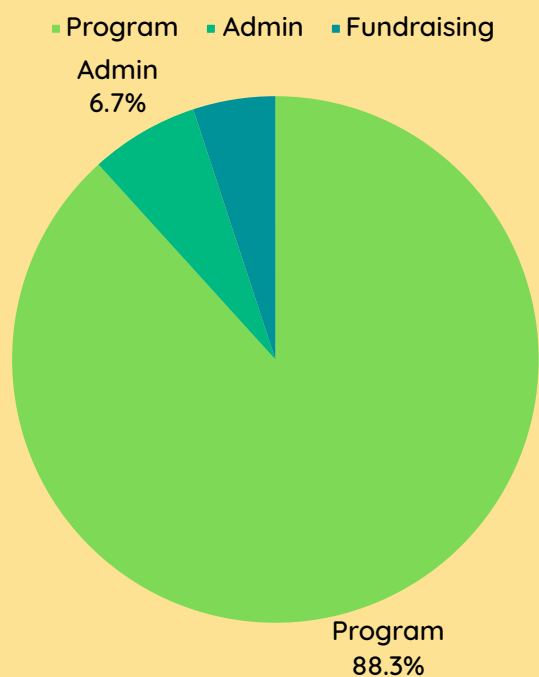
